If approved, this measure will finance capital costs of replacing aged and worn emergency response vehicles and equipment, including:						
<ul> <li>Purchase and equip five (5) fire engines;</li> <li>Purchase and equip five (5) ambulances;</li> <li>Purchase and equip one (1) command vehicle;</li> <li>Pay the costs associated with the bond issuance.</li> </ul> Bonds would mature in a period not to exceed five and one half (5 ½) years from the date of issue and may be issued in one or more series. The measure is estimated to cost taxpayers an average of \$0.16 per \$1,000 of assessed value each year. For the owner of a						
home or property owner, the estimated annual average cost would be \$16 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, annually.
