## **Fire/Lost Homes, How to get their Ballots?**

Voters need to know that they will continue to **use their current residential address** even if their residence has burned down; we are following ORS 247.

1. If the voter has a location where they are staying, the voter can update their **mailing address only** so their ballot will be mailed to that location by:
  - a. Emailing our election office at: [elections@klamathcounty.org](mailto:elections@klamathcounty.org) (we will need their name and year of birth **or** residence address, please don't put your full date of birth in e-mail).
  - b. Going to Oregonvotes.gov and under My Vote update their mailing address. Direct link to My Vote <https://sos.oregon.gov/voting/Pages/myvote.aspx?lang=en>
  - c. Call our office, 541-883-5134, and ask us to mail them a Voter Registration card or update address form.
2. If the voter moves again, they can update their mailing address again.
3. We will not mail ballots after Friday, October 30, as the voter would not receive it in time.
4. The voter can come into our office and fill out a ballot replacement form and we will give them their ballot at the counter.
5. Voters can go to any Oregon County Clerk's office, with ID, and request their specific ballot. The county will ensure the ballot is returned to the voter's home county for counting.
