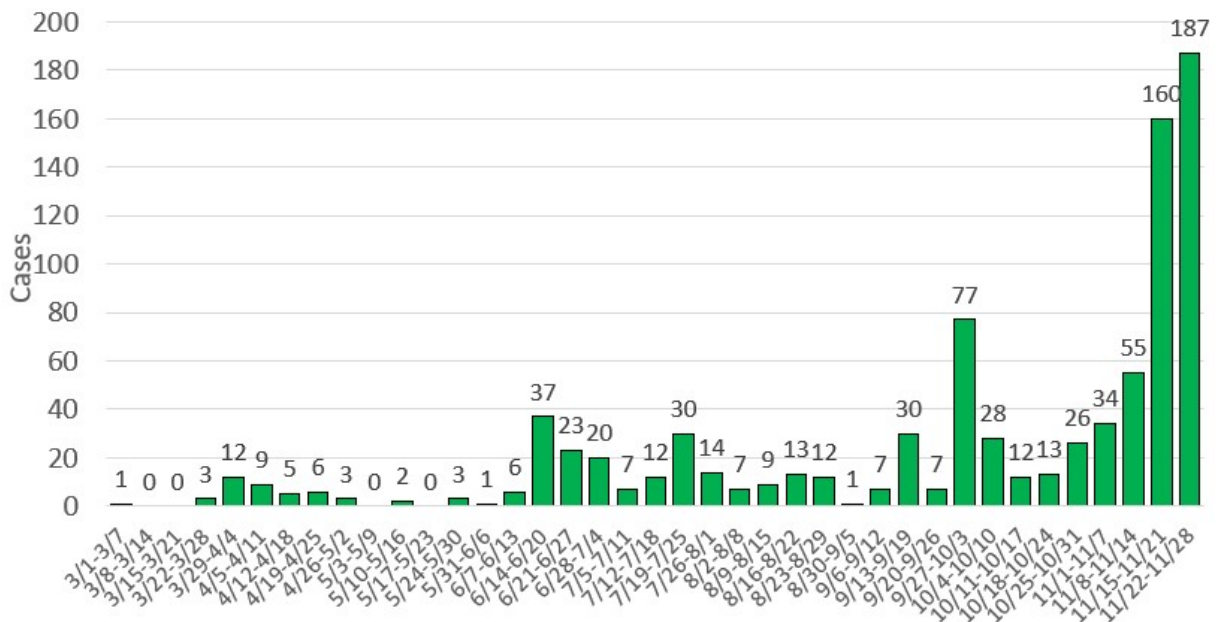

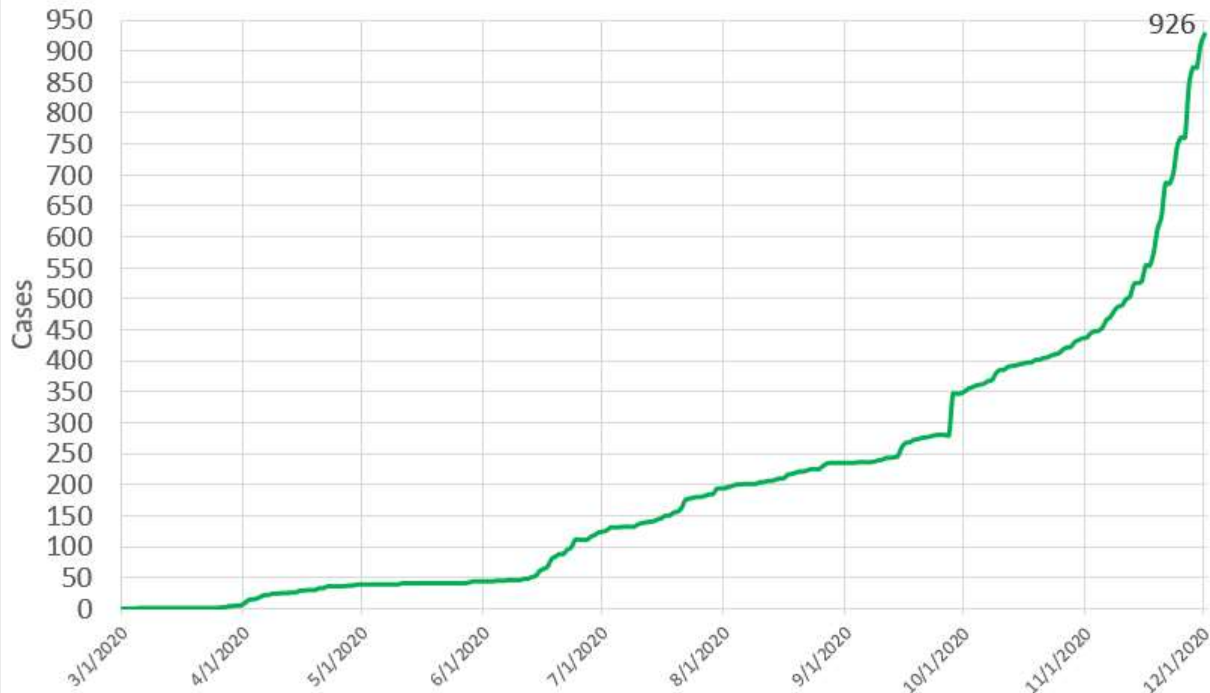

Klamath County Known COVID-19 Cases - Cumulative



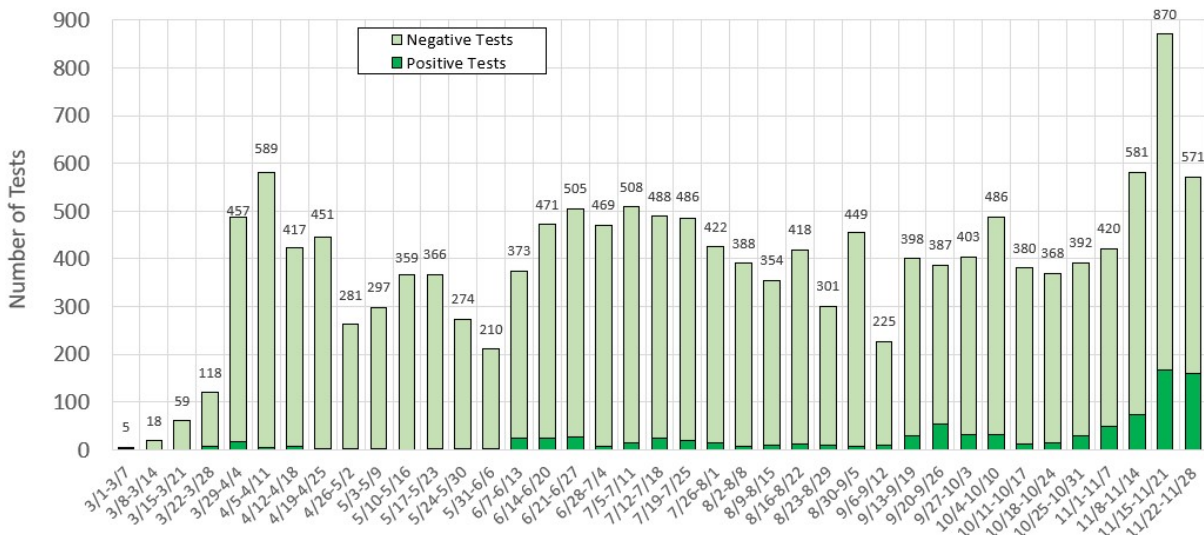

Klamath County Weekly COVID-19 Tests

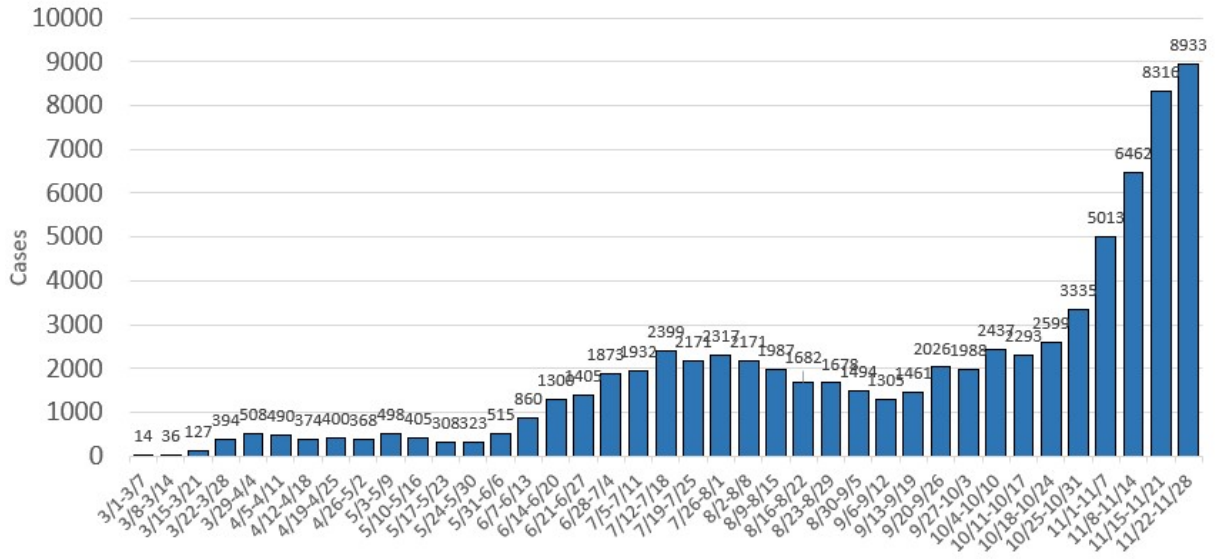

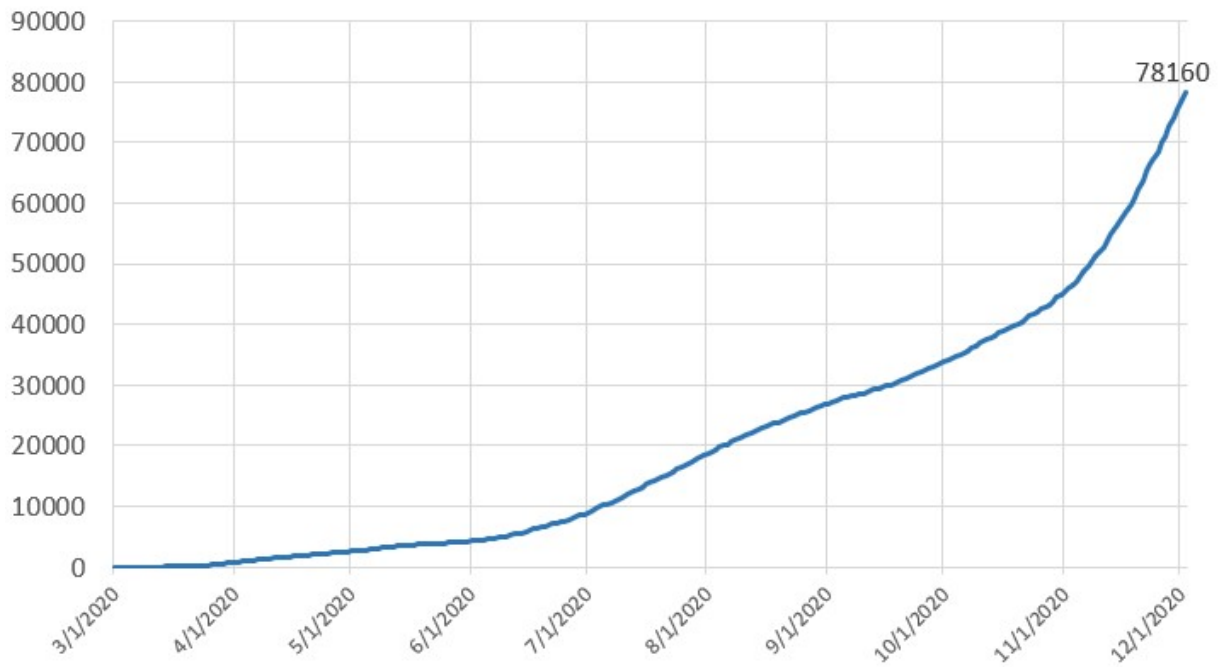

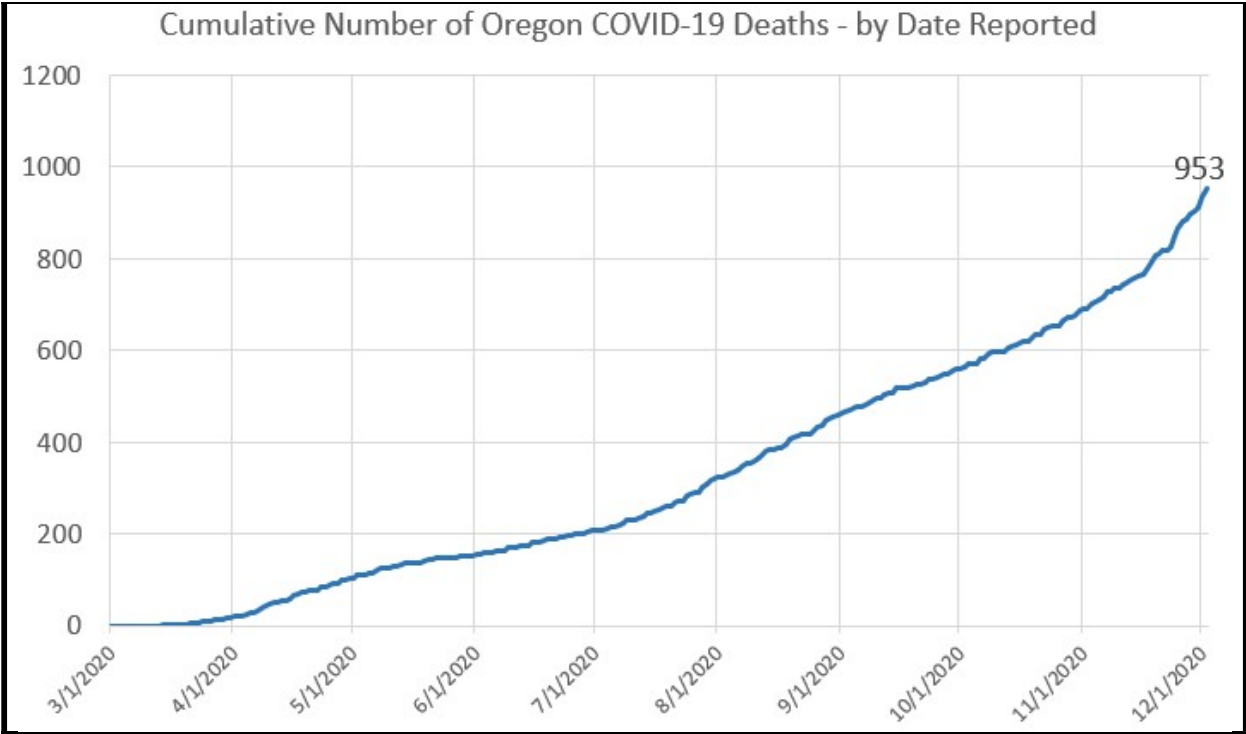
Oregon Known COVID-19 Cases - By Calendar Week

Cumulative Number of Known Oregon COVID-19 Cases - by Date Reported





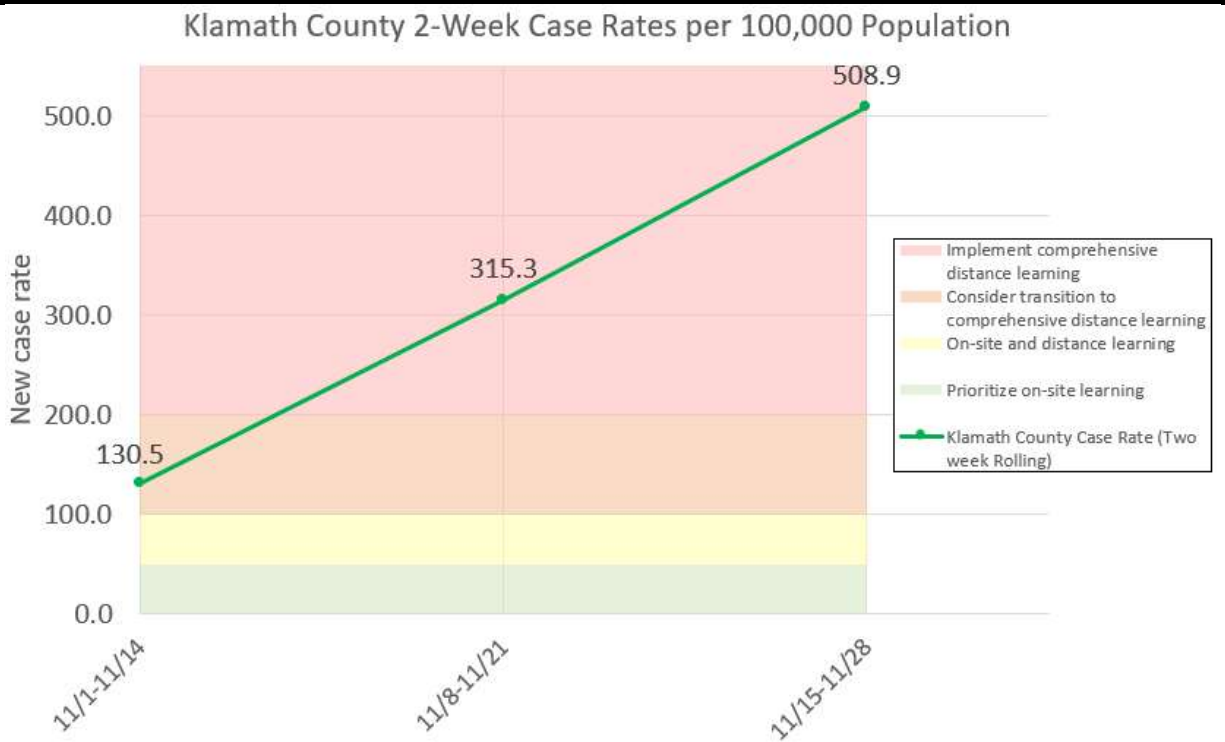
Public Health Indicators for Monitoring COVID-19 (OHA Dashboard)

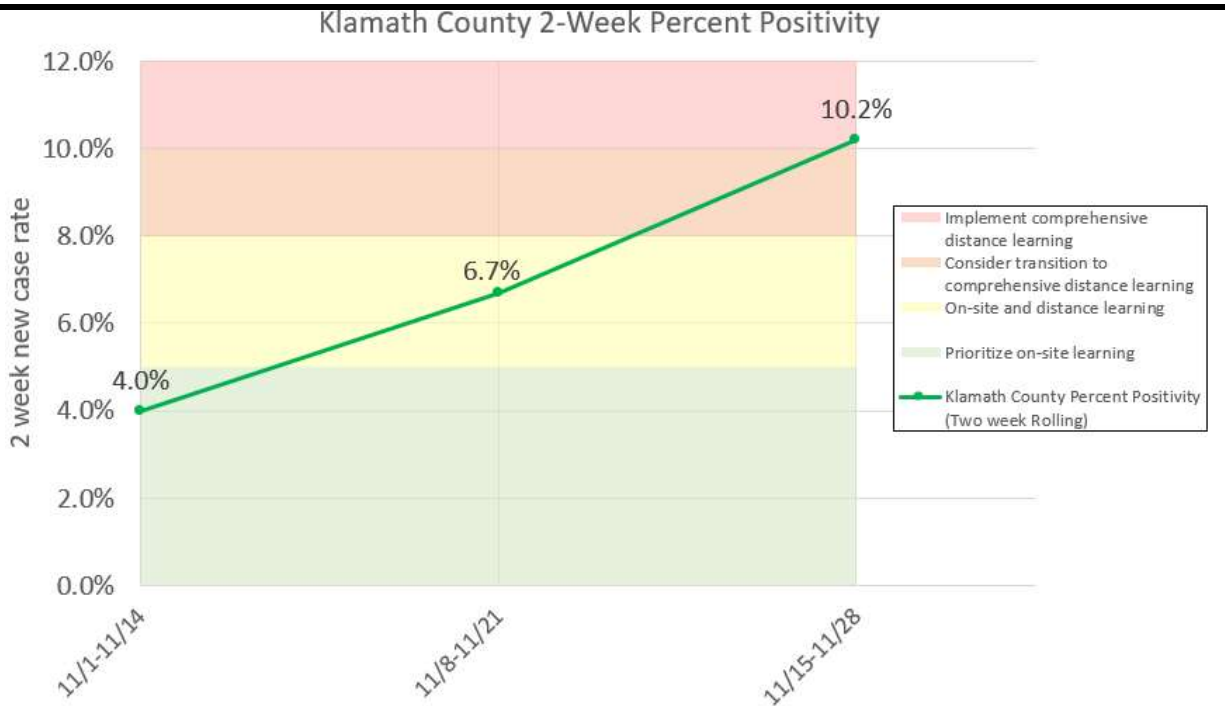

Ready Schools, Safe Learners: Community COVID-19 Metrics

New school metrics were recently released. Jefferson County is classified as a "small county" (<30,000 residents), which means that school reopening decisions are based on a 2-week county case count and a 2-week county test percent positivity.
